Mid-term exams will begin on **Wednesday, January 25** and will end on **Friday, January 27, 2012**. Make-up exams will take place on Monday, **January 30, 2012**. The exam schedule is as follows:

**WEDNESDAY, JANUARY 25<sup>TH</sup>:**

**All 9<sup>th</sup>, 10<sup>th</sup>, and 11<sup>th</sup> grade Science** classes (80 minutes) in the morning

**All A.P. Biology and A.P. Chemistry** classes (3 hours) in the morning

**All Art, Music, Health** classes (1 hour each) in the afternoon

**\*11<sup>th</sup> and 12<sup>th</sup> grade students** not assigned to Art or Music will report to the Commons.

**THURSDAY, JANUARY 26<sup>TH</sup>:**

**All 9<sup>th</sup>, 10<sup>th</sup>, and Honors 12<sup>th</sup> grade English** classes (80 minutes) in the morning

**All 11<sup>th</sup> and 12<sup>th</sup> grade A.P. English** classes (3 hours) in the morning

**All Math** classes (80 minutes) in the afternoon

**FRIDAY, JANUARY 27<sup>TH</sup>:**

**All History** classes (80 minutes) in the morning

**\*All seniors** participate in Final Presentations at RWJUH in the morning

**All Spanish** classes (80 minutes) in the afternoon

**\*All seniors** participate in Physical Education class in the afternoon

Students will attend their regularly scheduled classes and lunch between exams.

Students are expected to prepare for these examinations by reading and studying each evening. Students should be well-rested and have a hearty breakfast on exam days.

**Any student caught cheating on an exam will receive a grade of zero and a mandatory parent conference will be held.**

**All exam days are full school days.** Parents should make every effort to have their student in school on time. Students who are late to school will not be given extra time on their exams. Students should not be signed out of school early on exam days. Should school be closed on an exam day due to weather or other circumstances, the exam schedule will be moved back one day.
